	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Summary of experience portfolio (5500 words)</li> <li>• Case study (3000 words)</li> <li>• Record of a minimum of 48 hours of continuing professional development per year over a minimum of 2 years and</li> <li>• Pass the RICS Ethics test and</li> <li>• Attend a final interview at which a presentation on the case study must be delivered.</li> </ul>

The BSc (Hons) degree that is completed is determined by the selected occupational route.
