

### **Terms and Conditions**

1. By entering this competition, the entrant agrees that they are legally bound by these terms.
2. A consent form, signed by the entrant's parent or legal guardian, must accompany all entries.
3. This competition is open to students who are studying in Years 7 to 10 and are residing in England, except children of employees of the University College of Estate Management (UCEM).
