Fees

£1,150 per module for students commencing in the 2020/21 academic year x 17 modules.

Total programme fee: £19,550

Time Commitment

25-35 hours a week for 42 weeks per annum.

Each 20-credit module equates to a total of 200 study hours broken down between directed online learning, selfdirected learning and assessment. The breakdown between these three types of activity may vary between modules but on average is as follows:
