

Safeguarding Apprentices

UCEM applies some additional Safeguarding measures for apprentices, including:

- UCEM visits and risk assesses workshop venues;
- UCEM checks and reviews the health and safety of apprentices whilst they are learning with their employers;
- All apprentices are provided with a Learner Handbook at induction, which details information about Safeguarding and Prevent and how a student can contact UCEM with any concerns or queries;
- Safeguarding and Prevent is embedded throughout the curriculum of the L3 Surveying Technician Diploma Apprenticeship;
- L3 Surveying Technician Diploma apprentices are taught about fundamental British Values throughout their programme.

Reporting:

In addition to usual safeguarding reporting requirements (as stated in Code of Practice-Safeguarding and Prevent) UCEM are required to report certain safeguarding concerns to the ESFA:

- Safeguarding concerns relating to sexual violence which UCEM have referred to the Local Authority, the police, and/or adult/children's social care.
- Allegations of abuse made against a member of staff.
