## Commence Logbook

Progress review with A00 (every 12 weeks). Week 4-6 completion of the initial review

- Introduction meeting with your Coach Reviewer.
- You will be issued your login to your Maharah logbook.
- You will undertake regular meetings with your Coach Reviewer who will support your development of your logbook.
- You will be expected to record regular diary entries backed up with supporting documents. These must be shared with your Coach Reviewer and AOO.

# **Development Phase**

Progress review with A00 (every 12 weeks).

You will be expected to record regular diary entries backed up with supporting documents. These must be shared with your Coach Reviewer and AOO.

## **Gateway Readiness**

Progress review with A00 (every 12 weeks).

Continue to develop and record evidence in your logbook. These must be shared with your Coach Reviewer and AOO.

## **Continued Development Phase**

Progress review with A00 (every 12 weeks).

You will be expected to record regular diary entries backed up with supporting documents. These must be shared with your Coach Reviewer and AOO.

#### **Gateway**

Progress review with A00 (every 12 weeks)

- To have successfully completed 340 credits of the BSc Building Control Degree.
- Achieved minimum hours of off the job training.
- The logbook contains sufficient evidence of competency in all the knowledge, skills and behaviours as defined in the Building Control Surveyor Apprenticeship Standard.
- The logbook must be verified by your employer as being a true reflection of your experience.
- Completion of the gateway review form.

## **End-Point Assessment (EPA)**

Progress review with A00 (every 12 weeks).

The EPA is the final assessment for the integrated Building Control Surveyor BSc Honours Degree equating to 20 credits. It has two methods of assessment. The EPA must be completed within 6 months of progressing through the Gateway.



The 2 methods of assessment

### 1.Plan Evaluation Report Exam

- Takes place between weeks 20-22 of the EPA start date
- 4 hour exam under invigilated exam conditions
- Each question will test your ability to:
- evaluate plans
- determine any deficiencies in the proposal deposited for Building Regulation Approval
- identify any non-compliant details proposed
- write a plan evaluation report to the client identifying any non-compliant details proposed and highlight where any improvements could be made
- The exam will be made up of a total of 6 essay questions of which you will select 4 to be answered.

### 2. Panel Interview

- The interview will take place in the final two weeks of the EPA.
- You will sit a panel interview supported by the logbook, this will contain a comprehensive detailed record of your experience and achievements of each of the professional competencies.
- The final logbook for submission will be c.6000 words.
- The panel will be made up of two or three panel members.
- The panel members will review the logbook and formulate a set of questions based on the submission.
- The panel will reach consensus to award a mark of Distinction, Pass or not achieved.
